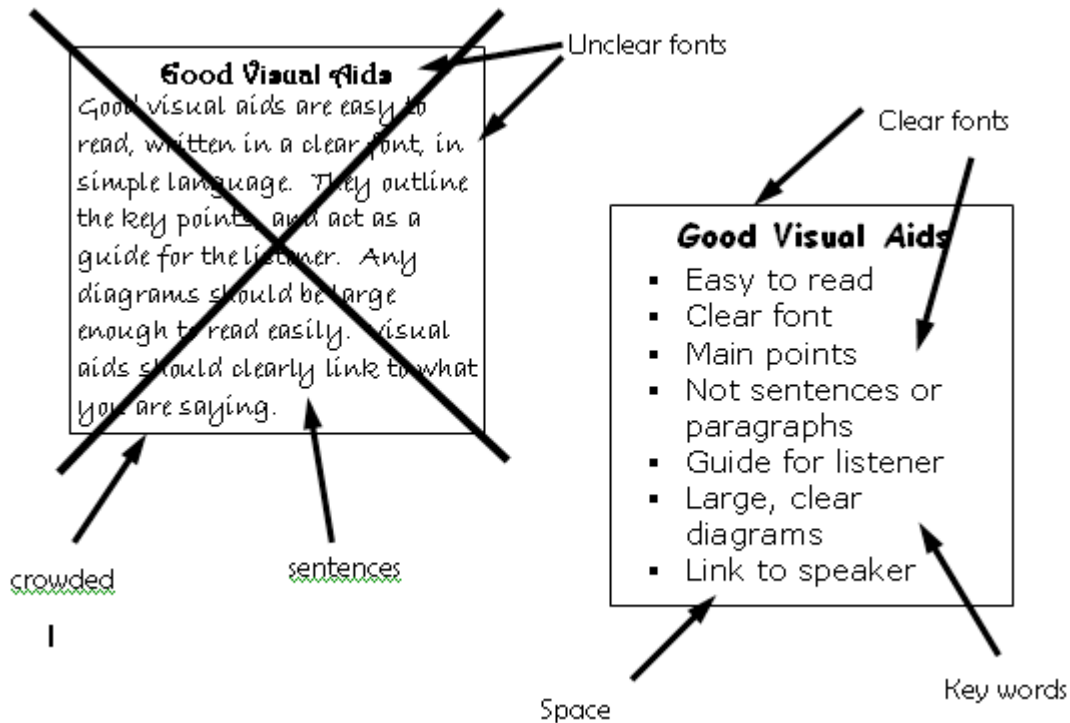


PRESENTATION VISUALS GUIDANCE

Firstly, please check the diagram below to see some general rules concerning how to effectively present your ideas & data to an audience:

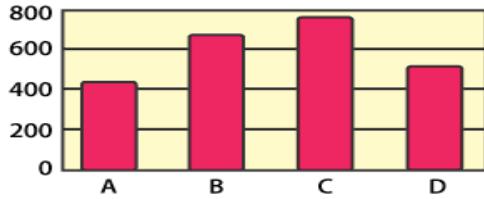

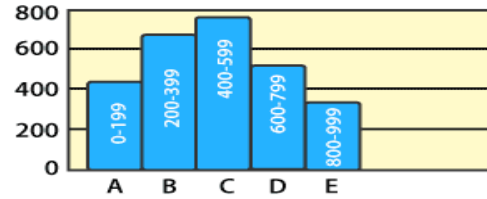

Bar Graphs



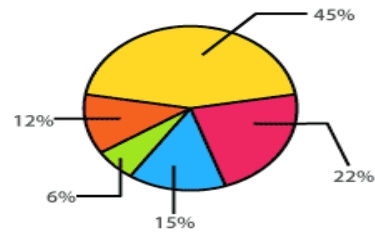

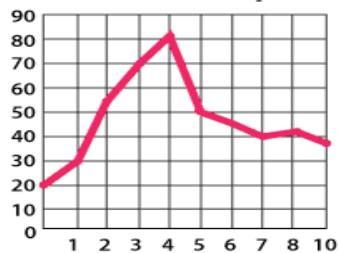

Stem and Leaf Plot

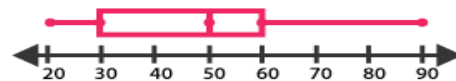
